You may work with two other students on this assignment (and if so, you can select a bill based on the first letter of one of your last names).

(A-E) The Clinton health care plan considered in 1993

(F-J) The first Bush Tax cut (Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001)

(K-O) McCain-Feingold campaign finance reform

(P-T) Bush Medicare prescription drug plan (Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act)

(U-Z) Clinton welfare reform bill (Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996)
